

AFFIDAVIT of M. Gene Wheaton

8 Nov 2010

The following is a "limited summary" of a few telephonic conversations I had with special Agent Julie M. Honey, Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS), Cold Case Homicide Unit, Camp Pendleton, California.

The conversations were the result of a note I received from her, dated 14 July 2010, and received by me on 17 July 2010, in which she asked me to call her about the work I did on the investigation of the death of Colonel James Sabow.

I initially called her ^{M.G.W.} on 19 July 2010, as she was preparing to board a plane enroute to Washington, D.C. on 20 July 2010, she called me back and was interested in what Randy Robinson told me ^{M.G.W.} related to events at Colonel Sabow's home on the date of his death.

After retrieving my handwritten notes and reviewing them I called her back on 28 July 2010, and discussed my interview of Robinson which occurred on 22 November 1992.

Among my cryptic notes of that interview I pointed out to Special Agent Haney that Robinson had told me that among the NIS (formerly Naval Investigative Service before being renamed NCIS) Agents present at the crime scene, there were two (2) female agents.

Robinson advised me that one of the female agents was named "Julie".

I asked Special Agent Haney if she was that agent named "Julie", to which, after a slight hesitation, she replied "yes", she was that agent at the scene.

Special Agent Haney had expressed an interest in meeting with me to discuss the investigation.

I have never heard from her again since mailing a copy of the 22 Nov 1992 interview I had with Randy Robinson.
