This is a report concerning physical evidence examinations requested by your office. In any future correspondence regarding this case please use the BFS case number appearing at the top of this report. If court testimony is required, please notify this office at least two weeks in advance whenever possible.

SUMMARY:

The samples from the left hand swabs were positive for the elements antimony and lead.

EVIDENCE AND INDICATED SOURCE:

One Kinderprint GSR collection kit from J. E. Sabow.

EXAMINATIONS:

The gunshot residue collection kit from Sabow was analyzed for the elements antimony and lead by atomic absorption spectrophotometry. These elements can be found in gunshot residues. Very high levels of antimony and lead were found on the palm and back of the left hand samples, while samples from the right hand were negative. This could be due to the left hand being near the muzzle of the discharging shotgun.

DISPOSITION:

The evidence is being held pending release to the submitting agency.
